Winston Churchill (1874-1965) failed sixth grade, but he didn't give up. He finished his schooling. He served in the military. He was a war correspondent before getting into politics. He was subsequently defeated in every election for public office until he became Prime Minister of England at the age of 62. As a world leader, he stood against Nazism during WWII. He was **DETERMINED** to work with others to stand strong for what was right.

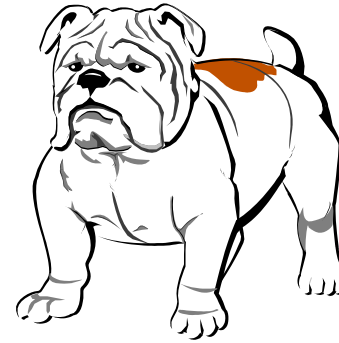
QUESTION 1: What do you think this great thinker and historical figure meant by saying "never give in EXCEPT to convictions of honor and good sense?"
