



Bible Notes

The Greek word ***diōkō*** (dē-ō'-kō) means “to run swiftly in order to catch a person or thing, to run after.”

Bible Notes

The Greek word ***ekkakeō*** (ek-kä-ke'-ō) means “to be utterly spiritless, to be wearied out, exhausted.”

This word, ***ekkakeo***, is found in 2 Thess. 3:13.

*“But ye brethren, do not become **weary** (ekkakeo) in well doing.”*

Bible Notes

The KJV translates ***ekkakeo*** as “be weary” two times: in Gal. 6:9 and 2 Thess. 3:13.

The KJV translates ***ekkakeo*** as “faint” four times: in Luke 18:1, 2 Cor. 4:1, 2 Cor. 4:16, and Eph. 3:13.

Bible Notes

“And let us not be weary (**ekkaneō**) in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint (**eklyō**) not.” Gal. 6:9

The Greek word **eklyō** (ek-lü'-ō) is also translated “faint.” This word means “to have one's strength relaxed, to be enfeebled through exhaustion, to grow weak, grow weary, be tired out, or to become despondent or to become fainthearted.”

Bible Notes

“ The days are coming,’ declares the Sovereign Lord, ‘when I will send a famine through the land - not a famine of food or a thirst for water, but a famine of hearing the words of the Lord. People will stagger from sea to sea and wander from north to east, searching for the word of the Lord, but they will not find it. In that day the lovely young women and strong young men will faint because of thirst.’ “
